



# CBM BRIGHTON

In June 2004, MHBC initiated a multi-faceted project for St. Marys Cement/CBM Aggregates to increase reserves at their Brighton area pit sites. The project included two concurrent licence applications to enlarge two existing pits onto three separate properties; and, to "upgrade" a Class 'B' licence to a Class 'A' licence. MHBC provided ARA, planning and project management services.

In order to provide efficiencies in cost and time to CBM, the applications were made concurrently and involved joint ARA open house events and PlanningAct public meetings. Particular care and attention was given throughout the project to clearly identify and differentiate the various applications and properties to the public. Licences were issued to CBM in June of 2005.
